

## **Russian Quota Scholarship Program for international Master's and PhD students to study at NArFU in 2016-2017 academic years**

Northern (Arctic) Federal University named after M.V. Lomonosov (Arkhangelsk, Russia) is pleased to invite international students seeking admission in 2016 to apply to Russian Quota Scholarship Program.

According to RF Government Regulation dated October 8, 2013 № 891 the program will sponsor international students by covering tuition fee and part of the living expenses during their studies in Russia. **The Quota scheme 2016 includes full-time studies and internships at Master's and Ph.D. level:**

Applicants for admission under the Quota Programme should provide the filled in **application form** and **copies of the following documents** to NArFU International Office **until June 20th, 2016:**

1. Filled in application form;
2. Copies of documents confirming subsequent educational levels including transcript of records \*;
3. Medical certificate issued by the official authority of the candidate residence country \*;
4. Certificate of HIV and AIDS negative test results issued by the official authority of the candidate residence country \*;
5. Copies of passport pages containing information required for study visa\*;
6. Other relevant documents (diplomas; international, national and other academic contest certificates)
7. Motivation Letter
8. CV

### **For admission to PhD programs:**

9. Abstract in Russian or English language;
10. List of publications.

\* Documents have to be translated into Russian language and notarized.

\*\* Copies of documents confirming subsequent educational levels including transcript of records have to be legalized.
